



2017 The First conference "Business Continuity ... Stability and Achievements"

The inaugural Business Continuity Conference in Qatar, held in December 2017 under the theme "Business Continuity, Stability and Achievement," successfully brought together over 400 participants from 153 public and private sector organizations.

The conference was organized under the patronage of HE Dr. Mohammed Bin Saleh Al Sada, Minister of Energy and Industry at the Four Seasons Hotel Doha on 3rd December 2017, with a strategic partnership with the Qatari Businessmen Association.

The conference reviewed the best practices in business continuity, risk management, and crisis response—particularly during the 2017 blockade. It emphasized cross-sector collaboration, crisis communication, and the implementation of frameworks like ISO 22301, while generating actionable recommendations to strengthen Qatar's resilience across economic, industrial, and social sectors.

The conference underscored the strategic importance of Business Continuity Management (BCM) in safeguarding Qatar's critical sectors from disruptions. By showcasing successful crisis responses and promoting BCM systems, it aimed to enhance institutional preparedness, ensure service continuity, and build long-term resilience. The discussions highlighted how coordinated efforts between government and private entities supported by standardized practices—can mitigate crises while protecting stakeholders, reputation, and national stability, aligning with Qatar's broader development goals.

2018 The **Second** conference "Towards a Reliable Economy"

The 2nd Business Continuity and Resilience Conference under the theme "Towards a Reliable Economy" was held under the patronage of the Ministry of Commerce and Industry " with the strategic partnership of the Qatari Businessmen Association (QBA), Professional Development partnerships with Business Continuity Institute in UK (BCI), BCI Qatar Forum, Institute of Risk Management (IRM), and Media Partnership with Dar Alarab.

The second edition of the conference brought together Qatar's largest gathering of business continuity, risk management, and organizational resilience experts, serving as a platform to exchange knowledge on integrating these disciplines into corporate governance. Focused discussions highlighted how transitioning to organizational resilience strengthens Qatar's economy, communities, and urban centers against disasters, while specialists shared critical insights on emergency preparedness, crisis response, and recovery strategies to enhance national resilience capabilities.


